COVID 19 AND THE EDUCATIONAL RESPONSE: NEW EDUCATIONAL AND SOCIAL REALITIES

Worldwide, the COVID 19 Pandemic has drastically affected the educational system. The only buzz word for all was “COVID 19”. Governments also decided to temporarily close educational institutions in an attempt to reduce the spread of COVID 19. During the pandemic, St. Francis de Sales Higher Secondary School, Narengi, Guwahati started online education for all the students in the month of March'20. SFS didn't let the pandemic affect the school's educational system. It scrambled to find creative solutions to teaching students online, in-person but socially distant, or in a hybrid format.

Parents and teachers played a fundamental role in supporting students to develop these crucial attitudes. SFS always loves challenges, which is why it took the entire situation positively and ensured that students continue with their learning. It was also difficult for the teachers, changing their teaching mode from offline to online. Rev. Fr. George Thomas, Principal of SFS Guwahati, encouraged each and everyone not to lose hope because life is not a bed of roses. SFS feels very proud of having a person like him as the backbone of the school.

CBSE BOARD EXAMINATION RESULTS 2019 – 2020

Amidst COVID 19, CBSE declared the results on 14th July 2020. 103 students appeared for Class XII Examination 2019-2020. The stream toppers of Class XII are Rubul Sarma from Commerce with 97% achievement, Partha Pratim Sarma from Science with 96% achievement Deepnayana Sinha from Humanities with 96% achievement. 22 students scored above 90%, 39 students scored 80-89%, 31 students scored 70-79% and 11 students scored 60-69%.

On 15th July 2020 the CBSE declared the results for Class X Examination 2019-2020. 52% of students are able to score more than 80% marks in this exam. The rank holders for Class X are Namrata Nayak with 97%, Nilanjan Das with 95.60% and Parismita Bordoloi with 95.60%.

SOLACE IN TIMES OF NEED – A MASSIVE PROGRAMME TO FEED THE POOR AND THE HUNGRY



St. Francis De Sales Higher Secondary School, Narengi, Guwahati, undertook a massive relief programme to feed the poor and hungry in collaboration with FASCE India (Fransalian Agency for Social Care and Education) from 4th April 2020. This was necessitated due to the unavoidable lockdown that started in the country for the COVID 19 Pandemic. The country was under a mandatory lockdown imposed by the central government for 21 days to arrest the spread of the virus. Amidst these preventive measures to combat COVID-19, daily wage labourers and migrant workers are among the worst affected as they cannot go out to work, earn their living and buy food. There have been reports that many people were forced to go without food during the lockdown.

SFS Narengi, with the help of Fr. Dr. Saji George Puthiyakulangara, Director of FASCE India and Staff took an initiative to distribute essential commodities like 5kg of Rice, 1kg Dal, 2kg Potato, 1lt Oil, 2 Soaps, and Masks to more than 750 families from localities including Satgaon, Narengi to Forest Gate Road. Rev. Fr. George Thomas, Principal of SFS Narengi says "Solace in Times of Need" Phase I was a huge relief to the hungry people around the locality.

FASCE India and SFS Narengi will continue with the relief programme in the days to come. Fr. George said that the motive was not just to distribute food but also to spread awareness about COVID-19 and personal hygiene.

SHIFT TO ONLINE TEACHING

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, excellence and equity, the cornerstones of our school system were challenged, and the urgent nature of the situation called for relevant and impactful solutions to reinvent the concept of learning. Real change often takes place in deep crisis and this pandemic too offered that golden opportunity. As a progressive school with a vision, we were determined to discover potential innovations to the educational challenges to the new situation. The initiation of remote teaching and learning process through the use of technology was the first major disruptive innovative step taken in this direction. The core idea was to design, mobilize and share the most innovative digital learning environment. A blend of activity-based instructional videos, discussion forums and live interactive classes started as early as 27th March 2020. The School's in-house software Desalite Connect was upgraded immediately to adapt to the current and future needs of the school community which integrated students' attendance, teachers' evaluation, homework submissions, academic assessments including the Class XI selection test in a single platform. As social distancing became the norm, virtual parents-teacher meetings and staff meetings were organized through digital platforms to reach out to every parent and teacher associated with the school. This enabled the school to build stronger relationships between the school and its primary stakeholders. Though technology is the lifeline of future education, at a time when we were unprepared for digital learning, to ensure equitable access to high-quality online education, the school organized a series of webinars, training, career and book fair for parents, teachers and students.

The pandemic gifted us a great opportunity to rework our systems and develop a deeper insight in terms of our strengths and weaknesses. The impact of disruptive innovations taken up by the school has been manifold. Due to the increased digital communication, our teachers got an excellent opportunity to form a stronger connection with parents. SFS teachers put up all efforts to nurture students effectively through online mode taking school to home and beating Corona.

While COVID-19 is spreading global destruction, the timely and visionary steps and solutions adopted by SFS Guwahati has made it future ready. The catastrophe was an ideal opportunity for the school to harness the power of innovation and technology to upgrade in the school and embrace the alternative ways of thinking. Our steps were instantaneous, keeping in mind the best interest of the child. And its impact is truly disruptive and may need another pandemic to erase.





DE SALITE ONLINE FIESTA 2020

Desalite Fiesta is the cultural fest organized by the school every year where the students showcase their cultural and literary talents but this time the parents were involved as well. Despite the pandemic, SFS conducted Desalite Fiesta virtually from 24th May to 21st June 2020 with a variety of online events such as Solo Dance Competition, Solo Singing Competition, Speech Competition and Story Telling Competition category wise. The most interesting event was the Family Group Singing Competition where parents participated with great enthusiasm. New interests and passions emerged among many students as they participated in the competitions of the Desalite Fiesta alongside numerous presentations. Overall we received a total count of 897 students participating for the events. Virtual competitions were able to show everyone the importance of learning experiences beyond the school building. Though 2020 had been quite difficult for everyone, SFS organized virtual events to keep everyone captivated in its crucial time.


TALENT HUNT CUM FRESHERS' DAY




BACK TO SCHOOL
